Fernando Blasco holds a PhD in Mathematical Sciences and is an Associate Professor of Applied Mathematics at the Polytechnic University of Madrid. Interested in scientific outreach, the relationship between education and dissemination, and the integration of science as part of culture, he has promoted innovative educational initiatives through recreational mathematics and mathematical magic. Since 2020, he has been the president of the Dissemination Commission of the Spanish Mathematical Society and a member of the Outreach and Engagement Committee of the European Mathematical Society.

For over 20 years, he has been a frequent speaker in teacher training courses, training for scientific museum guides, and numerous educational events both within Spain and internationally, especially in recent years in collaboration with the Cervantes Institute. He has built bridges between secondary and high school education and the university, collaborating in the presentation of the Polytechnic University of Madrid in educational centers, conducting activities to promote STEM subjects, and participating in committees developing university entrance exams. He regularly collaborates with the media and is responsible for the "Mathematics for Everyone" section on the program "On the Shoulders of Giants" on Radio Nacional de España.
